To improve quality education the District is asking for:

Authorization to exceed the state revenue limits on a recurring basis by \$525,000 beginning with the 2018-2019 school year.

The District is asking for approval to:

- Update our curriculum and our instructional practices (\$100,000 per year).
- Continue our technology improvements and growth (\$75,000 per year).
- Recruit and retain high quality teachers (\$200,000-\$300,000 per year).
- Perform quality facility maintenance and upkeep (\$100,000 per year).

The financial impact to our taxpayers:

With the retirement of our annual \$451,000 building debt and the expiration of our \$75,000 technology referendum this year, passage of a recurring \$525,000 operational referendum will result in no increase to the school tax rate.
