REMEDIAL READING PROGRAM
(Grades K-4)

The District shall provide remedial reading services for underachieving students in kindergarten through grade 4 as required by law.

All K-4 students shall be tested with an appropriate instrument(s) to determine if a reading problem is present. The District shall employ certified teachers who have earned at least six semester credits in courses dealing with the assessment of reading skills and/or the diagnosis of reading difficulties to direct, coordinate and provide remedial reading instruction. Transcripts of District teachers with these credentials shall be kept on file.

A remediation plan and/or activities for underachieving students shall be provided by the District reading specialist, school psychologist, learning disabilities teacher(s) and classroom teachers. Remedial reading instruction shall be coordinated with other reading instruction.
