FULL-TIME STUDENT

The District defines full-time students, for membership count purposes, as follows:

- Students in grades K-6 who are enrolled in classes for the full school day.
- Students in grades 7-12 who are scheduled in classes for at least six of the eight periods of the school day.
- A student with a disability who has been evaluated by an individualized education program (IEP) team and has been prescribed an IEP.
- A student who is participating in an alternative educational program or other program or curriculum modifications approved by the Board and/or school administration (e.g., children at risk programs, school age parent program, gifted and talented programming, homebound instruction, Youth Options Program classes.
- A resident student attending public school in another school district under the full-time public school open enrollment law or a tuition waiver under section 121.84(4) of the state statutes.
