## **BUDGET IMPLEMENTATION**

The District's operating budget shall be considered as a controlled spending plan for the ensuing year. The School Board places the responsibility for administering the operating budget, once adopted, with the District Administrator. When administering the budget, the Board expects the District Administrator to be guided by the following principles:

- 1. The budget will be administered in accordance with state laws and regulations.
- 2. Each school and department will operate under budget controls established by the Board.
- 3. No expenditure of funds will exceed the major function to which it is to be charged, except in accordance with state law.

The District Administrator shall keep the Board informed on the status of the budget at regular Board meetings.
