EMERGENCY SCHOOL CLOSINGS

The School Board believes that the safety and health of students and staff must be protected. Therefore, the Board authorizes the District Administrator to set up guidelines for the closing of school in the event of inclement weather or other emergency that threatens health and safety.

School shall be closed if the buses are unable to travel on the roads due to ice, snow or other conditions, and shall be closed for a period of time determined by public health officials if at any time 60% of the school population is absent as a result of a communicable disease. The District Administrator or designee may also close school at other times when it is determined that the safety or health of students or staff would be compromised.

The District Administrator or designee shall notify designated television and radio stations when school will be closed.
