## TRANSPORTATION OF FOUR-YEAR-OLD AND FIVE-YEAR-OLD KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS

In the interest of safety of the District's youngest bus riders, the District shall require the parent/guardian of a kindergarten student or another responsible adult designated by the student's parent/guardian to be present at the bus stop to receive the student after school. It is the responsibility of the student's parent/guardian to make arrangements for a responsible adult to be present at the bus stop and to inform the school of such arrangements.

If no responsible adult is present at the bus stop to receive the student, the student will not be allowed to disembark the bus. The student will remain on the bus and be transported back to school at the conclusion of the take home route. The student's parent/guardian or emergency contact person shall be called to come and pick up the student at school or make alternative additional transportation and supervision arrangements. The student's parent/guardian may be assessed costs associated with such alternative additional transportation and supervision arrangements.

The District shall notify parents/guardians of kindergarten students of this policy prior to the start of the school year.
