## CROWD CONTROL GUIDELINES

- 1. Crowd controllers shall arrive at the event 30 minutes prior to the start of the contest and stay to ensure there are no altercations between players or spectators.
- 2. Crowd controllers shall ensure spectators comply with sportsmanship expectations and monitor unruly behavior.
- 3. Crowd controllers shall ensure that spectators remain off equipment and the playing area during competition.
- 4. Flagrant disrespect, unruly behavior and the like by any spectator, which causes disruption of the event or surrounding spectators is cause for removal from the event.
- 5. Students suspected of coming onto school grounds intoxicated, or smelling of intoxicants, are to be taken to the office and the parent/guardian called to come pick them up. Crowd controllers shall report the incident to the principal as soon as possible. The same action will be taken for student fighting or other behavior that is unacceptable.
- 6. During indoor events, crowd controllers shall station themselves at the doors and restrict movement in and out when play is evident or where movement would hinder competition.
- 7. Crowd controllers shall periodically eye the crowd for proper control and take appropriate measures on behavior not conductive to good sportsmanship. Crowd controllers shall use appropriate judgment in their actions.
- 8. Crowd controllers shall restrict access to the interior halls of the building and periodically patrol the halls to be sure students are not in these areas.
- 9. Crowd controllers shall help ensure safety is maintained at all times by the crowd by taking appropriate actions to prevent possible injuries to spectators.
- 10. Crowd controllers shall enforce the rules of no beverages in the gymnasium, and remind students that if they leave the contest they will not be allowed back in.
- 11. Crowd controllers shall escort officials for the contest(s) to the appropriate locker room/facilities before the contest, at half time, and after the contest.
