OPERATIONS: Day to Day

- Face Coverings:
 Optional for staff and students
- Visitors: Limit nonessential visitors and volunteers, but allowed with pre-approval by administrators
- Physical Distancing:
 Classrooms will
 maintain 3' distancing
 as possible
- Entrances & Exits:
 Use of multiple
 entrances/exits to
 decrease student
 grouping

OPERATIONS: Healthy Environment

- Cleaning and Disinfecting: Continue regular cleaning protocols
- Ventilation:

 Continued monitoring of upgrades to ventilation system

- Drinking Water:
 Bottle filling stations available
- Hand Hygiene:
 Hand sanitizer
 available for students
 and staff throughout
 the building

OPERATIONS: Transportation

- Face Coverings:
 Required as per CDC
 order
- Health and Safety:
 Buses will be
 disinfected regularly
 with special attention
 to high touch areas
- Student Capacity:
 Assigned seating;
 siblings will be seated together as much as possible
- Self-Transport:

 Families choosing to transport their children should notify Northern Express bus service

Instructional Model: In-Person

- In-Person
 Instruction: All K-12
 students will be in
 person 5 days a week.
 The 4K program will be
 Mon-Thurs as normal.
- Field Trips: Field trips will be possible as appropriate.
- ONO Fully Virtual Option Available: Instruction will be in person without the previous full virtual option. Individual virtual courses for curriculum offerings we do not have at the school will still be available.

Extra-Curricular Activities

- Face Coverings:

 Optional for players/
 participants and
 spectators but required
 when on buses.
- Limits: There will be no limits on student participation in activities or number of community spectators

- Physical Distancing: Not required for practices, activities or for spectators
- Concessions: There will be concessions available at activities

Quarantine Protocols

- The district will be following Portage County quarantine guidelines and recommendations, At this time Portage County will be conducting contact tracing.
- Guidelines include the following for those considered close contacts:
 - A fully vaccinated person who is asymptomatic does not have to quarantine.
 - A not fully vaccinated person must quarantine for 10 days after their last close contact without testing or 7 days with a negative test result on day 6 or 7.
- All protocols are subject to change based on guidance from CDC, DHS, WIAA and Portage County
